

Circumstances Change...God Doesn't

Matthew 28:18-20...Go, Make, Baptize, Teach

Our lives, plans, and comfort zones have been altered and/or shifted. Our work has been transformed, and in some cases, completely eliminated. In-person gatherings have been cancelled, re-scheduled, or placed on some Larry D. Phillips media platform.

> But God's mission to "seek and save the lost" (Luke 19:10) hasn't changed! His call to obedience, "Repent and be Baptized" (Acts 2:38) hasn't changed! His plea to "walk as Jesus did," (I John 2:6) hasn't changed,

and His exhortation to "let the peace that Christ gives control your thinking" (Colossians 3:15), hasn't changed!

So, what do we do with this information. Well, there are 3 things we can immediately do ... 1st, pray that God will allow us to see the souls whose hearts have been opened by this virus. 2nd is to pivot. We have been going at breakneck speed in many directions and God is allowing us to stop, look, and listen. And 3rd, rethink our previous methods of telling others about Jesus. Try one or all of the following:

- Use Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn, and Twitter, to write scriptures. (I know someone that is lined up to begin teaching on YouTube, beginning in August)
- Text or call your friends and tell your servers you'll pray for them. (restaurant, store, mail carriers, package deliverers, first responders, medical personnel, teachers, etc.) Their responses will surprise you and it could be life changing for someone.
- Involve yourself with World Bible School. That is probably the easiest way to tell others about Jesus.
- Become involved with your small group at MCOC. And if you are not in a small group we'll find one for you. Call the office.

Remember, circumstances change, but God doesn't!


